Day tickets are available from the usual outlets

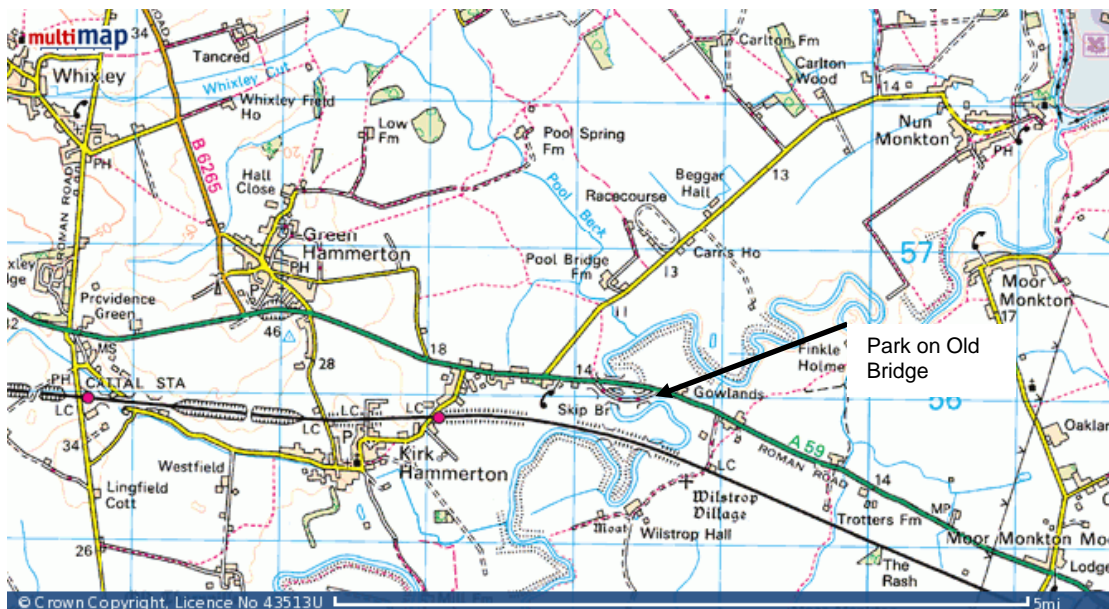
Night Fishing is allowed by prior arrangement via the Waters secretary

A short fast stretch of water with loads of character.

A feature packed stretch of the lower Nidd, suits a roving approach, many shallow glides with some deeper pools.

This stretch contains a good head of barbel, chub, dace, and roach with occasional brown trout and grayling.

Occasionally match fished, opposite bank is held by Leeds and District Amalgamated Society of Anglers, so can be busy in summer months at weekends



Take the A59 (Harrogate) from York, to Skip Bridge. Park on the Old Bridge, and access via the stile.
