FISHERY MAINTENANCE. I have received adverse comment recently about the parlous state of some of our fisheries, namely Burn Road and Hemingbrough Ponds and the waters south of the City on both banks, resulting in the complainants saying they would not renew their membership if the situation did not improve. The latter venues may affect the current Winter League Series but in all cases when the members were asked if they would be prepared to put some hours in to help improve their venues apathy ruled and they declined any volunteer help. As the average age of your Committees is 63 years, (12 of the 21 over 60) it therefore becomes necessary for the general and fitter members of the Amalgamation to 'get down and dirty' to ensure the future continuation of access and availability of our fishing. The recent survey questionnaire resulted in a number of members stating that they would be prepared to engage in bankwork, but names have not been confirmed.

KIRKHAM/HOWSHAM BARNFIELD. The following report has been received from a member.--
The footpath after the wood is quite muddy and treacherous and the footbridge has broken boards. For that reason NYCC have closed this path. The closure sign was not there upon arrival but when I left a notice had been posted to the gate at the entrance to the field. It will no doubt affect the many walkers but I would suggest that if one wishes to fish up to the first field there should be no problem. Whilst the footbridge is just passable, NYCC are covering themselves against anyone injuring themselves. -
